

## Eligibility

1. The award is for a full-time student who is a British or an Austrian citizen and who is (or who intends to be) registered for doctoral study at a university in the United Kingdom.
2. The award is for doctoral research for which some relationship to Austria can be demonstrated.
3. The award may be used for tuition fees or maintenance, or to assist with research costs (e.g. travel, cost of materials).

## Value of the Award

4. The value of the award is £10,000 per annum.
5. The award is paid in two equal instalments in each academic year, the first payable on 1st October and the second on 1st April.

## Conditions

6. The intention is that the award will be held by the same full-time doctoral student for a maximum of three years, or until the completion of the final full year of full-time doctoral study, provided that the student's progress is deemed by The Anglo-Austrian Society to be satisfactory.
7. Renewal of the award for the second or for subsequent years will be conditional on written confirmation to the Society by the awardholder's supervisor before the beginning of the following year
  - (i) that the student has made satisfactory progress with their research, and
  - (ii) that it is anticipated that the research will be completed within the period of the award.

8. The name of the holder of the award will be published in the Society's Newsletter.
  
9. From the second year of registration, the awardholder of the award will be invited to give a talk on their research to members of The Anglo-Austrian Society. The awardholder will also be expected to write an account of the research being undertaken, to be published in the Society's Newsletter.
